


Recommended HTML improvements

- 65 Duplicate page titles
- 822 Duplicate meta descriptions
- Just as many duplicate keywords

All due to save as publishing behaviour. Resulting in inaccurate page information for search results

Title creation guide

'Brand and item name' - 'Detail (e.g. like colour if relevant)' - Store name

<title>Thrasher Skateboarding Magazine Logo Hoodie - Black - Hardcore Hobbies</title>


Improved checkout experience

Based on our in-store user study, customers could not find the checkout after adding goods to their shopping cart.

Why? The 'Go to checkout' button was buried among other links in a sidebar. Not a primary call to action.
